Dear Congressman Sensenbrenner:

Thank you for your letter on the United States trade agenda, including the ongoing Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) agreement and Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (T-TIP) agreement negotiations. I appreciate your support for the Bipartisan Congressional Trade Priorities and Accountability Act of 2015 (TPA), through which Congress sets transparency requirements for trade negotiations and establishes negotiating objectives to achieve in any trade agreements prior to bring them to Congress for a vote.

The Administration recognizes that the 2015 TPA bill does not provide the Administration any new authority to enter into climate change agreements. In addition, the Administration is not negotiating language or provisions related to population control, family planning, or related topics.
