In response to this year's record snow fall totals, President Bush declared emergency disaster aid would be available to seven counties in Southeastern Wisconsin. This is much needed help for communities who have had to tighten already pinched budgets to provide for the safety of its residents.

However, notably absent from the declaration were Waukesha and Ozaukee Counties, both of which had snow fall totals nearly meeting or exceeding previous records. With this concern in mind, I would ask that further evaluation be given for these two counties.
